Background



Original course developed by Seacroft in the late 90s

Shell / MSF resurrected the course 2 or 3 years ago

Uptake on existing course has dwindled

Existing course content in need of updating

MSF approached the Safety Hub as existing provider of MSF branded courses to develop a Marine Awareness Course to run in parallel with existing providers

Safety Hub approached Seacroft to provide marine expertise in the development and delivery of the course

Bookings and administration of the course will be managed by the Safety Hub

What has changed?



- Course reduced to 1 day duration
 - New format developed to accommodate this.
 - Greater buy in from delegates
 - Less cost to delegate organisations
 - Course costs
- Existing material reviewed and changed but still retains existing key point areas of learning
- Strong practical element for a practical audience
 - Less of PowerPoint overload, more on discussion and interaction
 - Greater appreciation of vessel crew perspective
 - Visits to vessel and offshore base not seen as beneficial
- Vessel simulation exercises

Key Items



Key Items

- Discussion based learning. Course instructors experienced in marine and offshore ops.
- Use of incidents such as Mumbai High and attendees experiences.
- Use of Operations Manuals (Company Specific if Required), Policies & Guidelines.
- Simulator Based exercises to reinforce topics covered in a practical way.
- Simulator also promotes team building and decision making.
- Simulator is an effective method of providing appreciation of operations from vessel perspective.
- Course Assessment.
