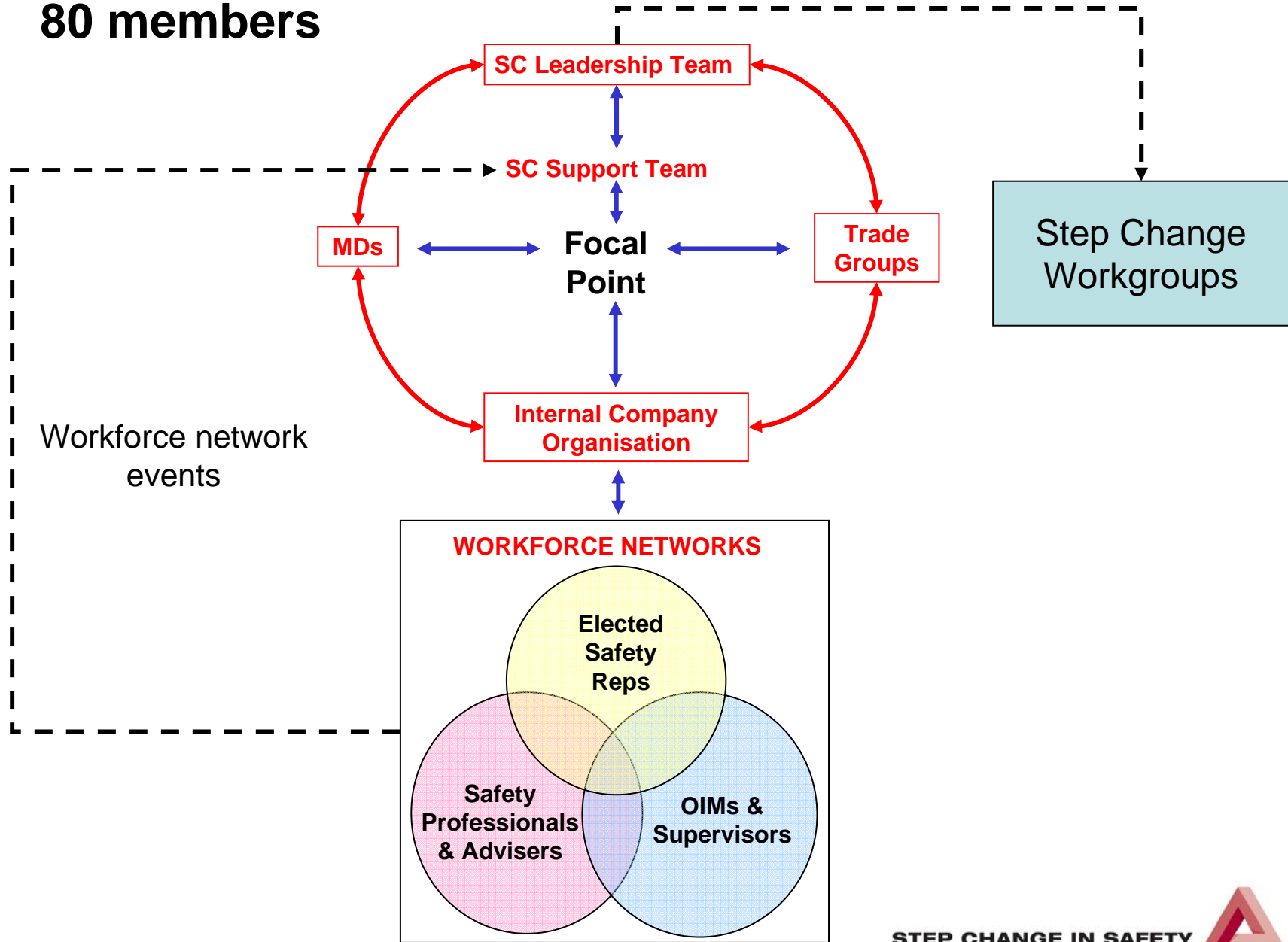

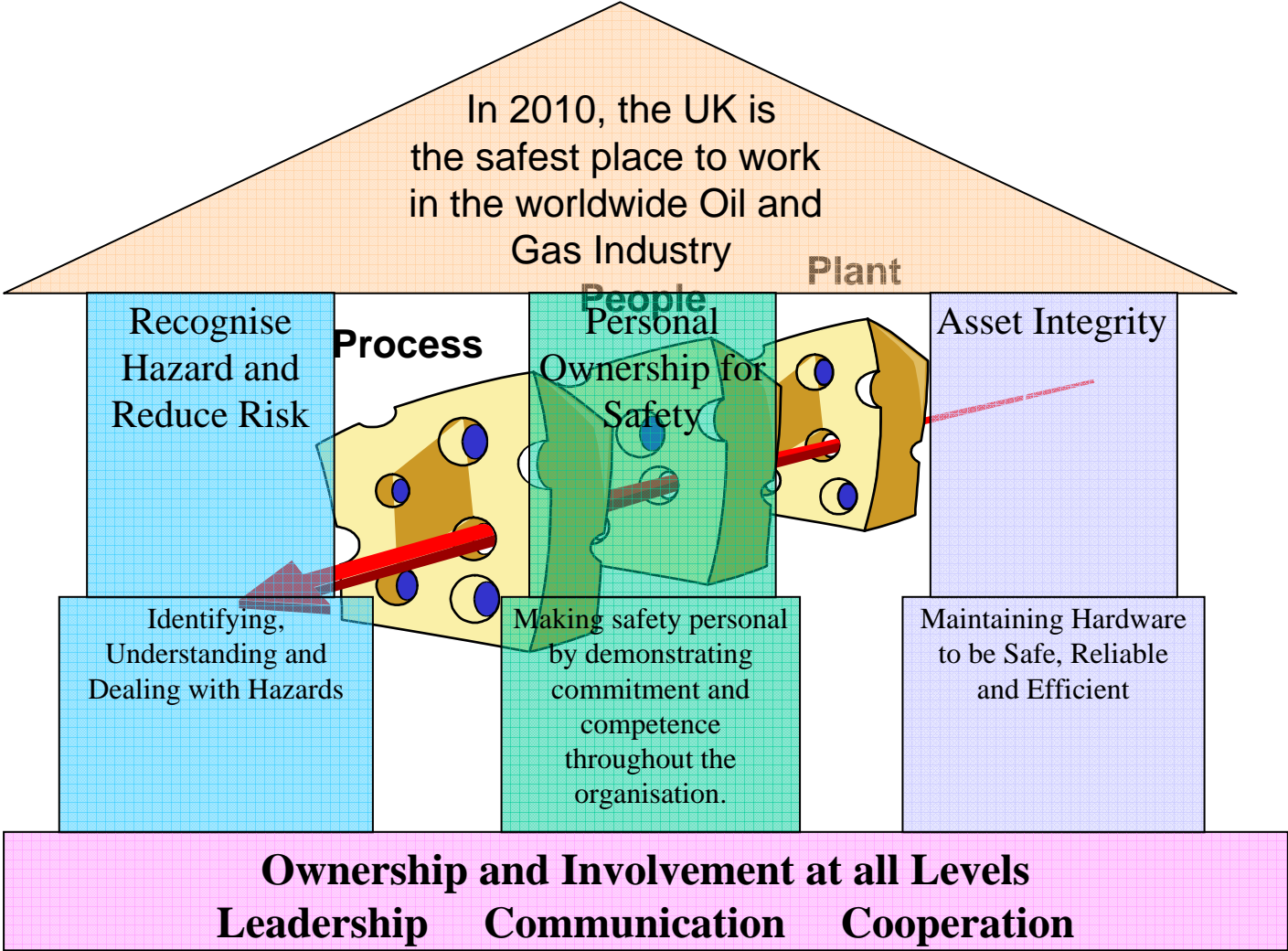

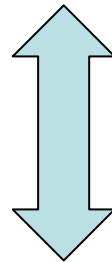

## The 'Step Change in Safety' cashpoint

- Withdrawals limited by size and quantity of deposits
